### **Senate Approves FY 2010 Consolidated Appropriations Conference Report**

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Senate today approved the Fiscal Year 2010 Consolidated Appropriations Conference Report by a vote of 57 to 35. The legislation will now go to the President for his expected signature.

The underlying bill is the FY 2010 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies Appropriations conference report. In addition, the Commerce, Justice, Science, and Related Agencies; Financial Services and General Government; Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies; Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related Agencies; and State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs are included in the consolidated legislation. Combined, the six bills total \$446.8 billion in discretionary budget authority.
