Dear Chairman Tiberi:

As you know, the current Tax Code is riddled with temporary tax provisions commonly referred to as "tax extenders." These temporary provisions make it difficult for employers to plan, invest, and create jobs, and they provide a clear example of why comprehensive tax reform is so necessary. The last time that the tax extenders were examined, in 2010, House Republicans were able to eliminate 73 of these temporary provisions. As we have discussed, I believe that we must again examine these provisions to determine which represent policy appropriately pursued through the Tax Code.

Please consider this letter my request to you to hold a hearing for the purpose of examining this issue.

I look forward to continuing to work closely with you and the other Members of the Subcommittee on this and other issues.
