In conjunction with the development of the 2011 Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP), CHFA is currently revising its Standards of Design and Construction for affordable rental housing for 2011.

Two open forums for public comment and discussion of the Public Review Draft of the proposed revised Standards have been scheduled: the first for September 7, 2010 from 9:00 to 10:30 AM at CHFA, 999 West Street in Rocky Hill, CT 06067; and the second on September 8, 2010 from 1:00 to 2:30 PM at the Norwalk Elderly Community Room, 1 Leonard Street, Norwalk, CT 06850.

These are opportunities for developers, design professionals, contractors, and other interested parties to influence CHFA's standards and requirements for the planning, approval and execution of the affordable rental housing developments it finances for families, the elderly, and others with special housing needs in Connecticut.

A redlined Public Review Draft of the proposed 2011 Standards of Design and Construction will be available shortly to view and download in the CHFA Multifamily Underwriting Document Library. Developers, design professionals, contractors, and other interested parties are encouraged to read through the documents and bring their questions, comments and concerns to the forum.
