## 2011-2012 Qualified Action Plan

A preliminary version of the 2011-2012 Qualified Action Plan (QAP) will be available on KHC's [Web site](#) by close of business tomorrow, Tuesday, September 21, 2010. Developers who use the Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program for the production of affordable multifamily housing are encouraged to review this draft version prior the [Kentucky Affordable Housing Conference](#), Wednesday and Thursday, September 22-23, at the Louisville Marriott Downtown. An informal multifamily developers roundtable forum will be held during the conference to solicit feedback on this draft version. Additional details (time and location) will be announced during the conference.

This forum does not take the place of the required public hearing for the QAP. KHC is using this opportunity to gather as much partner feedback as possible in the development of this two-year QAP. Comments received during this forum will be incorporated into the draft QAP, which will be made public the last of this month (September 2010). A formal public hearing will be held on Wednesday, October 6, 2010. Additional details will be forthcoming in a future eGram.
