SUBJECT: ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE IDEAS FOR 2013 QAP
DATE: JANUARY 18, 2012

As part of the process of significantly re-writing the Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) for 2013, the Authority is making available the opportunity for all stakeholders to be able to submit their ideas for alternative language for any portion of the QAP. Essentially, if a stakeholder has thoughts or ideas on language for a specific area of the QAP and feels it could be presented in a better way than the 2012 QAP is currently written, the stakeholder can re-write that section of the QAP the way they would like to see it written, and send it to the Authority. Authority staff will review and take all alternative language submissions into consideration when putting together the draft 2013 QAP. However, to allow for enough time for consideration in the process of drafting the QAP, the Authority is only making this opportunity available until February 10, 2012.
