Midwestern Disaster Tax Relief

H.R. 1424 provides tax relief for victims of the Midwestern disaster in Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska and Wisconsin, including an additional \$8 per capita in low-income housing tax credit (LIHTC) authority in 2008, 2009 and 2010.

The relief provisions are applicable counties in the those states that are presidentially-declared major disaster areas determined to warrant individual assistance, individual and public assistance, or public only assistance due to flooding, tornadoes or severe storms on or after May 20, 2008, and before August 1, 2008.
