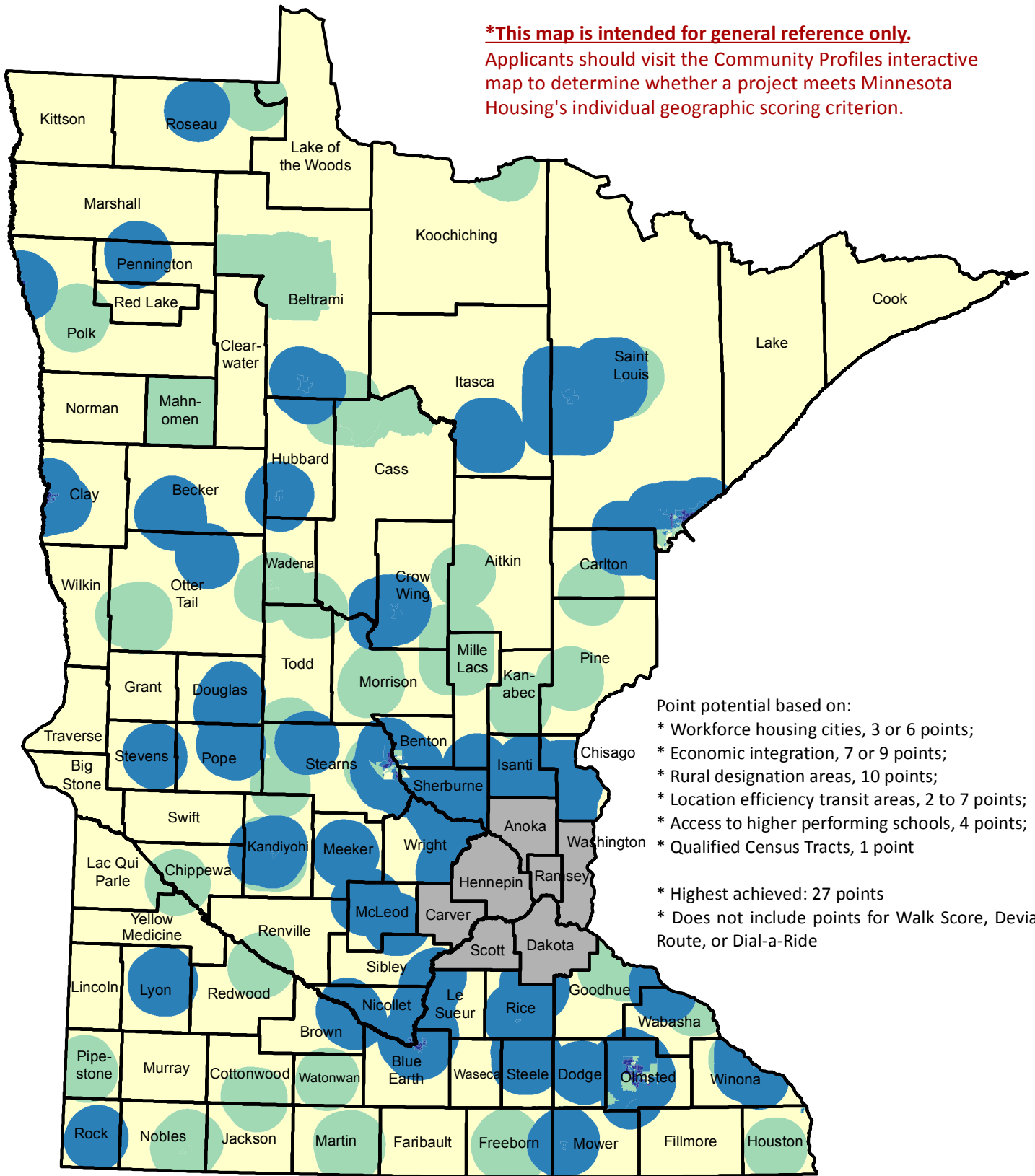


Combined Geographic Priority Point Potential, 2019 QAP: Greater Minnesota

Point potential based on:

- * Workforce housing cities, 3 or 6 points;
- * Economic integration, 7 or 9 points;
- * Rural designation areas, 10 points;
- * Location efficiency transit areas, 2 to 7 points;
- * Access to higher performing schools, 4 points;
- * Qualified Census Tracts, 1 point
