

Request for Proposals Issued for 2010 Housing Tax Credits

Rhode Island Housing seeks proposals for 2010 Housing Tax Credits. Applications will be accepted for the construction and/or rehabilitation of affordable apartments throughout the state of Rhode Island with an emphasis on family housing. Priority will be given to proposals that revitalize neighborhoods impacted by the foreclosure crisis, address neighborhoods with aging and deteriorated homes, communities that develop apartments in areas that lack affordable rental homes and developments designated as KeepSpace proposals. Proposals must call for: (1) at least a minimum of 20 units; and (2) meet the required minimum set aside.
