Re: Returned 2008 Disaster Relief Credits

Dear Mr. Lucas:

As the Executive Director of the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority (WHEDA), I am requesting a confirming letter regarding the position of the U.S. Treasury related to the utilization of Returned 2008 Disaster Credits. Specifically WHEDA is requesting confirmation by a U.S. Treasury letter that 2008 Disaster Relief Credits which are returned in 2009, may be reallocated in 2009.

I reference Mr. Mundaca's letter dated April 27, 2009 to the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency which indicated similar authority regarding so called GO Zone Credits.

I also reference your email dated August 10, 2009 to Bill Boerigter, a member of my staff, which seems to somewhat informally confirm this position for Disaster Relief Credits.

I am sure you can appreciate our desire to remove all uncertainty from this issue.

In short, I am asking for a letter from your office to me, as it relates to this subject matter, so that I can maximize the production of affordable housing under the Section 42 program in Wisconsin this year.
