Different maps are required throughout the Multifamily Uniform Application to meet certain threshold and selection criteria requirements. The following is list of websites and software packages that applicants may use to meet threshold and selection criteria. Refer to the *2010 Application Submission Procedures Manual* (“ASPM”) for specific map requirements.

Please note that this is not an exhaustive list and the Department does not recommend any one company over another. As long as the minimum requirements of the 2010 QAP and ASPM are met, it does not matter what mapping application is used.
