

2010 Proposed Multifamily Housing Evaluation Policy Changes

The Capital Projects Division proposes two changes to the Multifamily Housing Evaluation Policy. Points will be awarded for participation in Washington State Quality Award (or similar program), and for 100% nonprofit ownership of a project. Other areas of the Housing Evaluation Policy will remain the same.

New Point Criteria:

Washington State Quality Award (WSQA): 5 points. For applicants who have completed the full examination Washington State Quality Award program, or comparable nationally-recognized program similar or equivalent to the Baldrige National Quality Program criteria, within the last three years.

Modified Point Criteria:

Qualified Nonprofit Participation: 15 points. For Qualified Nonprofits who will have 100% ownership interest in the project.
